Davis, Julius PVT	Stevens's	unk	"prisoner with enemy" on November 25, 1776 roll

Freeman, Titus PVT	Osgood's	unk	possible/circumstantial – Knoblock <sup>2</sup>
Gillet, Simon PVT	Green's	20	about four weeks per pension
Gray, Daniel PVT	McKinstry's	unk	“captured by Iroquois, sold to British” (possibly post-Cedars) <sup>3</sup>
Hardison, Benjamin PVT	Sullivan's	19	see <i>Down the Warpath to the Cedars</i> , chapter 18
Hewit, Randall PVT	Stevens's	14-15	see <i>Down the Warpath to the Cedars</i> , chapter 18
Hollister, Jesse SGT	McKinstry's	24	about twelve days per pension
James, John PVT	Sullivan's	22	until October 1776, exchanged in Elizabethtown NJ per pension
Kingsbury, Joseph PVT	Osgood's	16	at least through June 1778, returned <sup>4</sup>
Meachum, Ichabod PVT	Sullivan's	17	nine weeks, escaped to British, exchanged July 1777 per pension
Middleton, Reuben PVT	Osgood's	unk	see <i>Down the Warpath to the Cedars</i> , see chapter 18
Monty, Claude PVT	Hamtramck's	15	seven or eight months per pension
Pasco, Jonathan PVT	Sullivan's	16	nearly one month, escaped, returned to camp by 25 December 1776 per pension

Scott, John PVT	McKinstry's	unk	captured (possibly post-Cedars) <sup>5</sup>
Smart, Richard PVT	Osgood's	unk	short period, escaped per pension
Spencer, Abner PVT	Stevens's	unk	"prisoner with the enemy" on November 25, 1776 roll
<b>Tellison, Jonathan PVT</b>	<b>McKinstry's</b>	<b>unk</b>	<b>captured in Canada (possibly post-Cedars)</b>
Wooster, John PVT	Sullivan's	24	more than one year, until about September 1777, escaped per pension
